8/13/26	A Sunday Horse (2016)	Not Rated	Cypress Hall 1-3:30pm	After a near-fatal accident, on a horse the experts thought was nothing special, a determined rider from the wrong side of the tracks defies all the odds to pursue her dreams of winning a national jumping championship. Filmed in Ocala
8/27/26	Across the Universe (2007)	PG-13	Cypress Hall 1-3pm	The music of the Beatles, New York in the 1960s, and the American youth's actions to protest the Vietnam War, form the backdrop for the romance between an upper-class American girl and a poor Liverpool artist.
